**Prerequisite:** Successful completion of Spanish II **Graduation Reg:** Fine Arts or Practical Arts

This course will build vocabulary and grammar comprehension and use through the Interpretive, Interpersonal, and Presentational Modes. Students will expand their language skills in order to progress to advanced Spanish classes.

Prerequisite: Complete Spanish III with a C or higher

**Graduation Reg:** Elective

Spanish for Leadership is a course that will allow students to apply the Spanish they have learned in previous courses to career-related situations. Students will develop 21st century skills such as leadership and collaboration while working on class projects with a focus on improving written and spoken communication skills. Students will take their Spanish usage outside of the classroom to connect with our community for various projects, as well as use Spanish to work on projects to help various organizations that work with communities in Spanish-speaking countries. Topics to be covered include the cultures and economic, governmental, environmental, and social systems of different Spanish-speaking countries. This course will provide the knowledge and skills needed to be successful in a globally competitive society. This course is NOT NCAA approved.

Spanish IV **Credit:** \$203 online text **Grade:** 95631S1 & 95631S2 and website license 10-12



**Prerequisite:** Successful completion of Spanish III **Graduation Reg:** Fine Arts or Practical Arts

This course is an ACC concurrent enrollment course, and is a college level course. Students continue building their fluency in the language through Interpretoral, Interpretive, and Presentational Modes. Classes are conducted mainly in Spanish.
